

First Responder (FR) Training Programs

GVK EMRI ensures best education environment that fosters and stimulates learning of skills, knowledge and attitude to respond to an emergency situation and patient, effectively and efficiently. Contemporary learning methodologies, such as simulation with manikins and hands on practice are the foundation of GVK EMRI training & provide unique experiential learning opportunity to every single participant of training program. GVK EMRI strives to impart training at par with global standards of education and learning by partnering with best institutes in the world.

First Responder (FR) Training Program (Rural, Urban, Police, FIRE) is the first and vital link to a good emergency response system for any society. This program aims to develop first responders who are trained in simple, life-saving medical techniques that can be performed with minimal equipment. During the course the participants are trained in Scene Safety, Personal Protection equipment (wearing mask, gloves and goggles) and how to activate an Emergency Response System. This program equips the participants with essential preliminary care skills like giving rescue chest compressions and performs first aid for medical, trauma and environmental emergencies. This is a one day program designed by GVK EMRI. This program strengthens chain of survival in society.

The course content is as follows:

- Breathing Difficulty (Asthma, severe allergy, Choking)
- Chest Pain/Heart Attack, Low blood sugar, Brain Stroke, Fits/Convulsions/Seizures
- Fainting, Cardiac Arrest and CPR, Bleeding and shock, Wounds/Fractures, Sprain
- Head injury, Back/spinal Injuries, Burns/Electrocution, Heat stroke, Near drowning

- Snake bite/Insect bites, Poisoning
- Hands-on training in:
Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
Automated External Defibrillator (AED)

Methodology:

- Audio-visual sessions
- Didactic and Group discussions
- Hands-on practice on manikins

Benefits

To the Participant

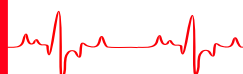
- Establish the primary link in the chain of survival

Duration of Training – 1 day

Course Fee :

Rs. 608/- per participant
Minimum enrolment per batch: 30
