ITLS is accepted internationally as the standard training course for pre-hospital trauma care. ITLS course combine classroom learning and hands-on skill stations. Scenario assessment stations enable student to put himself in simulated trauma situations. To be certified, a course must be taught by registered ITLS instructors under the sponsorship of ITLS International, an ITLS chapter, or an ITLS training centre. ITLS empowers health care personnel with the knowledge and skills to provide optimal care for the trauma victims. GVK EMRI has been accorded a chapter status organization by ITLS, USA.

**Certified as:** ITLS Advanced Provider

**Prerequisites:** The candidate must be an advanced level practitioner such as certified EMT-Advanced, Paramedic, Nurse, Physician, or other allied Health professional who holds suitable qualifications for entry.

**Criteria to be certified as ITLS Advanced provider :**

A student has to attend all the lectures and skill stations, should get at least 74% in the written test and qualified as "adequate" in patient assessment.

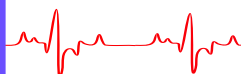

**Duration of Training - 2 days**

### Course Fee :

ITLS Basic/Advanced - Rs.4,500/- per participant\* (Non Residential Program) Minimum enrolment per batch:15

If training is conducted in the host organization, then host organization is expected to bear the travel, boarding and lodging costs of the resource person. Residential Program) Minimum enrolment per batch: 20
