- 4. Other General instructions to be followed by bidders.

ARTICLE - 1: COST OF BIDDING

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the bid and GVK EMRI will, in no case, be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.





ARTICLE - 2: LANGUAGE OF BID

English language only.

ARTICLE - 3: PHYSICAL SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS COMPRISING THE BIDS

Sealed prequalification cover containing Tender Fee & Earnest Money in a separate cover along with IT returns and financial statements for last three years, Excise Duty/Sales Tax/VAT registration, Copy of PAN/TIN, relevant manufacturing licenses and satisfactory certificates for the similar business work from existing reputed customers to be submitted at our office.

ARTICLE - 4: BID PRICE (ONLY ON LINE)

- a. Firm Price
- b. Unit prices shall be considered correct in the event of any discrepancy with regard to total price, if any.
- c. **Price Basis:** The Prices shall be based as defined elsewhere in the tender document inclusive of all taxes & duties.


ARTICLE - 5: PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF BIDS

- a. Bids shall be kept valid for one year from the opening of commercial bid. A bid valid for a shorter period may be rejected by GVK EMRI as non -responsive. The period can be extended mutually.
- b. In exceptional circumstances, GVK EMRI may solicit the bidder's consent to an extension of the period of validity. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing or by cable or Telex/Fax. A bidder granting the request will not be required nor permitted to modify substance of his bid or change the price.
- c. The Earnest Money deposited by successful bidder shall be forfeited if the bidder does not accept the order with agreed terms and conditions or does not execute the order after acceptance thereof within the completion schedule mentioned in the tender. Earnest Money deposited by the successful bidder shall be returned on submission of Contract Performance Guarantee.
- d. The Earnest Money of the unsuccessful bidders will be refunded after the finalization of tender.

5. General Terms and Conditions for Supply of Mannequins.

- 1. Mannequins detailed specifications: Annexure I, Part A & B
- 2. Workmanship criteria for acceptance : Annexure II
- 3. Eligibility Criteria:
- a. Bidder shall either be a manufacturer or a distributor/dealer having experience of supplying







- Mannequins or Bio-medical equipment/Instruments.
- b. Average Annual Turnover of the dealer/distributor (bidder) in the last three financial years from sales of Mannequins or Bio-medical equipment/Instruments shall not be less than Rs.25 (Twenty Five) Lakhs.
- c. Manufacturer participating as bidder or manufacturer from whom the tendered items would be sourced by the dealer should have an average Annual Turnover of Rs.200 (Rupees Two Hundred) Lakhs in the last three financial years.
- d. Manufacturer of Mannequins or Bio-medical equipment/Instruments should have valid certification as mentioned in Annexure VII of Technical Specifications.
- e. Bidder shall have experience in supply of Mannequins or Bio-medical Equipment/Instruments in the last 3 (three) financial years and value of a single order for similar items executed for a Govt. organization/reputed organisation during this period should be at least Rs.5.00 Lakhs.
- f. Company/Firm/Manufacturer which has not been blacklisted either by the Tender Inviting Authority or by any State Government or Central Government.

4. Submission of tenders:

- i) The Tender Fee, EMD and Supporting document should contain all the required registration / licenses, manufacturers experience, relevant satisfactory certificates, financial statements and IT returns for the past 3 years along with all tender documents duly signed on each page by proper authority and should be submitted physically as mentioned in schedule above to GVK EMRI GUJARAT, Naroda Kathwada Office. Please refer Annexure VII for check list.
- ii) Online Tenders without physical submission of Tender Fees, EMD and Supporting Documents duly signed will not be considered and will be summarily rejected.
- iii) Tenderer should quote their prices (Only Online) in the scheduled format specified in the online tender form. Tenders received in any other form will not be entertained.
- iv) Bidders seeking any clarification may attend the pre-bid meeting for clarity before bidding.
- v) No Conditional offer will be considered and will be liable to be rejected.
- 5. **Validity of the tender:** The tenders quoted shall remain valid for a period of One year from the date of opening of tenders and can be extended on mutual agreement.

6. EMD Amount:

- i) EMD in the form of a Demand Draft for an amount Rs. **100,000/- (Rs. One Lakh Only)** in favor of "GVK Emergency Management and Research Institute" payable at Ahmedabad to be submitted physically in a sealed cover labeled as "EMD COVER".
 - Bank Guarantee in favor of GVK EMRI, Gujarat can also be submitted in lieu of Demand Draft for EMD amount which would be valid for a period of **6 months** issued by any nationalized banks / other authorized banks (i.e. IDBI,AXIS, HDFC Bank and ICICI Bank).
- ii) The EMD will be withheld until the finalization of the tender





- iii) Successful Tenderer who fails to execute the order and supply Mannequins shall not be eligible for refund of EMD/SD.
- iv) For unsuccessful tenderer the EMD will be returned after finalization of Tendering process.

7. Price:

- i) The price offered in the online tender should be as per the FINANCIAL BID format consisting of all costs, duties and taxes applicable, including transit insurance up to delivery at Ahmedabad or any other location as specified by GVK EMRI.
- ii) All costs and tax components should be shown separately in the Invoice. GVK EMRI may claim back the taxes and duties wherever permissible.

8. Technical evaluation

- i) Technical evaluation of the tender will be done by a Technical Committee constituted by GVK EMRI and Govt. of Gujarat.
- ii) Tenders submitted with technical specifications mentioned in this tender form will only be considered.
- **9. Warranty:** The manufacturer should provide onsite warranty of 3 year **from the P.O completion date**, against any manufacturing defect.
- 10. GVK EMRI neither recommends any vendor selected within or outside tender specifications nor is responsible for any technical and/or commercial disputes.
- 11. **Opening of online tenders:** Tenders submitted online will be opened as per schedule mentioned above for Technical bids. Commercial bids will be opened after evaluation of technical bid.
- 12. **Delivery / Supply schedule:** The successful tendered has to supply Mannequins within 45 days of date of Purchase Order Issue.
- 13. **Re-Allocation / Cancellation of tender:** In case of failure on the part of the successful tenderer to deliver with in the stipulated date mentioned in the purchase order, GVK EMRI may cancel the purchase order in full, or part, and re-allot the same to next lowest tenderer who otherwise fulfills all conditions. and any extra expenditure involved due to this change will be recovered from un successful vendor deposit /out standing.
- 14. **Order Quantity:** The actual order quantity may increase or decrease from tender quantity; the delivery schedule will be amended keeping the same time lines in the Purchase Order for increased quantity. The tender Quantity may be divided among multiple vendors in case of need.
- 15. Liquidated damages (L.D) for late delivery:

15.1 GVK EMRI will levy/deduct for delayed supply, a penalty of 0.5% of supply value per week on successful tenderer, who is given the purchase order, and who fails to deliver the Mannequins as per the delivery schedule. The maximum L.D. will be charged within a ceiling of **10% of PO value**.







15.2 Once the maximum price reduction is reached, termination of the contract may be considered. Non-performance of the contract provisions shall make the successful bidder liable to be disqualified to participate in any tender for the next 5 years, in addition to forfeiture of Security Deposit and other penal actions.

15.3 Alternative Purchase

If the successful Bidder fails to execute the order within the stipulated time, the Tender Inviting Authority will beat liberty to make alternative arrangements for purchase of the Mannequins for which the purchase orders have been placed, from any other source or from the open market, at the risk and cost of the supplier. This would be in addition to any other penalties including forfeiture of security deposit.

15.4 Shortage and Damage

It shall be the responsibility of the successful Bidder for any shortages/damages at the time of receipt in the designated sites. Tender Inviting Authority is not responsible for the stock of items received, for which no order is placed.

15.5 TRANSPORTATION

Transportation of goods and transit insurance upto the specified destination will be by road or as specified in the PO and shall be in supplier's scope.

- 16. **Payment terms:** Payment will be made within 30 days of delivery, inspection, acceptance and submission of invoice.
- 17. Performance Security Deposit: The successful bidder, within 15 days of receipt of acceptance letter of intent/ Purchase Order, shall be required to submit Performance Security Deposit of 5% of the order value in the form of Performance Bank Guarantee in favor of "GVK Emergency Management Research Institute, Gujarat", payable at Ahmedabad valid for a period of 3 years from the date of acceptance of purchase order with additional 3 months claim period. The Bank Guarantee shall be returned on completion of the Warranty period of the goods supplied.
 - However, if the supplier fails to execute the order or fails to perform the services as per contract, in addition to other penal actions, the Bank Guarantee shall be en-cashed & the amount forfeited.
- 18. Liability of GVK EMRI: As the payment against the supplies under this agreement will be made by GVK EMRI on behalf of and upon release of funds from respective State Government, It is expressly understood and agreed by, between the SUPPLIER and the GVK EMRI that the GVK EMRI is entering into this Agreement solely on behalf of respective State Government. In particular, it is expressly understood and agreed that the though respective State Governments / Government of India are not a party to this Agreement and have no liabilities, obligations or rights hereunder, any delay in the release of vendor payments, for the supplies made under this tender, solely depend on timely receipt of funds for the same from the respective state governments. The SUPPLIER expressly agrees, acknowledges and understands that the GVK EMRI is not responsible for any delays in the release of funds from respective state governments for what so ever reason it may be and shall not hold GVK EMRI responsible for delayed payments and GVK EMRI shall not be liable for any acts, omissions, commissions, breaches or other wrongs arising out of the contract. Accordingly, the SUPPLIER hereby, expressly waives releases and foregoes any and all actions or claims, including cross claims, impleader claims or counter claims against the GVK EMRI arising out of this Agreement and not to sue GVKEMRI for any reason, as to any manner, claim, cause of action or thing whatsoever arising of or under this Agreement. However, GVK EMRI will persuade with respective State Government to enable the timely payment to respective Supplier.







- 19. **Ethics:** Any attempt by a tenderer to obtain confidential information, enter into unlawful agreement with competitors or influence the committee or the Contracting Authority during the process of examining, clarifying, evaluating and comparing tenders shall make the tender submitted by that tenderer liable for rejection.
- 20. **Jurisdiction:** All disputes arising out of or in connection with this tender shall be referred to law courts with Ahmedabad Jurisdiction only.
- 21. **Power of Cancellation:** GVK EMRI reserves the right to cancel the tender notification and reject any or all the tenders, at any time during the process of receipt, evaluation, and finalization of tenders, without assigning any reason what-so-ever.
- 22. **Force Majeure:** If at any time during the validity of the Contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligation under this Contract shall be prevented or delayed by reasons of War, Hostility, Acts of Public Enemy, Civil Commotion(s), Sabotage, Fire(s), Flood(s), Explosion(s), Epidemic, Quarantine Restrictions, Acts of State or Acts of God, hereinafter referred to as eventualities, then the Contract period will get extended for the period of Force Majeure, provided Notice of the happenings of any such eventualities is given, supported by a certificate of appropriate authority or Chamber of Commerce by either party to the other within 15 days from the date of occurrence thereof. Neither party shall by reason of such eventualities be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non performance or delay in performance. Work under this contract shall resume as soon as practicable after such eventualities have come to an end or ceased to exist and the decision of the Company as to whether the work has to be resumed shall be final and conclusive. Should one or both parties be prevented from fulfilling their contractual obligations by state of Force Majeure lasting continuously for a period of at least three months, the parties shall consult each other regarding further continuation of the Contract.

23. Fraud & Corruption:

The bidders, suppliers & contractors shall observe the highest standard of ethics during bidding and during performance of the contract. For the purposes of this provision, the following acts shall be considered as corrupt and / or fraudulent practices.

- "Corrupt Practice" means offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting directly or indirectly, of any thing of value to influence the action of an official in the procurement process or in contract execution.
- "Fraudulent Practice" means misrepresentation or omission of facts in order to execution of contract
- "Collusive practice" means a scheme or arrangement between two or more bidders, with or without the knowledge of the purchaser, designed to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive level.
- "Coercive Practice" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in a procurement process or in execution of a contract.
 - During the process of evaluation of a bid or proposal for award of a contract, if it is detected that a bidder directly or through agent has engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practice in competing for the contract in question, then a) the bid shall be rejected and b) declare the firm ineligible for a specific period or indefinitely to participate in a bidding process.

24. Saving Clause

No suit, prosecution or any legal proceedings shall lie against Tender Inviting Authority or any person for anything that is done in good faith or intended to be done in pursuance of tender.

- **25. Arbitration Clause:** In case of any dispute, the decision of COO GVK EMRI Gujarat will be final and honored.
- 26. Termination
- 26.1Termination: GVK EMRI reserving right to terminate this contract without cause by issuing 30 days prior notice to supplier.
- 26.2 The supplier also terminate this contract by issuing 60 days prior notice to the purchaser, however, there shall be no termination by supplier within initial six months of this contract.

1. Birthing Simulator

Manikin should be effective for multi-professional team approach training focusing on key skills for obstetrical care. Hybrid simulation adds realism to scenarios by providing real human interaction allowing participants to practice communication skills

Technical Specifications

The manikin should be an articulating full-body female with facility for automatic delivery.

The manikin should have facility to intubate and have visible chest rise.

The manikin should have IV arm for IV insertion practice.

The manikin should have removable stomach cover, fetal heart sounds, automatic birthing system, cervical dilation.

The manikin should allow teaching Leopold maneuvers, auscultation of fetal heart sounds, practice of suturing for episiotomy.

- Anatomically accurate perineum and pelvic floor muscles, with bony pelvis model
- The abdominal skin can be removed to display anatomical structures and fetal positioning
- Representative full term baby with:
 - Palpable fontanel and suture lines
 - Articulating baby can be presented in multiple positions to represent difficult and routine deliveries
 - Palpable clavicles and scapulae
 - Detachable placenta
 - Umbilical cord
- Mother allows for multiple delivery positions and techniques:
 - Normal delivery
 - Breech delivery
 - Vacuum delivery
 - Shoulder dystocia management
 - Forceps delivery
 - Delivery of placenta
 - PPH management





2. Pelvic Manikin

The manikin should resemble female pelvic model. Pubic bone should model should withstand the pressure. Baby movement of the baby should be easier and to be controlled by a trainer. Should allow teaching

- Normal delivery,
- Shoulder dystocia,
- Cord prolapse.
- Breech delivery
- Delivery of the placenta
- PPH Management

The manikin should be provided with

- A fetus
- Umbilical cords
- Placenta

3. Adult ACLS Manikin

The Manikin should be a full body manikin designed to run advance life support course. The manikin should allow to teach patient assessment and physical examination skills including

- Head to toe examination
- Pupillary reaction with multiple scenarios
- Tongue swelling (angioedema)
- Carotid pulse
- Visible chest rise
- Lung auscultation including normal and abnormal breath sounds
- Pneumothorax
- Heart sound including normal and abnormal
- Bowel sound
- Blood pressure measurement
- ECG monitoring

The manikin should allow to teach airway technique including Headtilt chin lift, C-E technique for Mask holding, jaw thrust. All basic, supra glottis, advanced airways and surgical airway procedures

The manikin should have CPR feedback as per 2015 guidelines. The manikin should have feedback on depth chest compression, chest recoil, rate of compression, interruption time, ventilation volume and should also provide score on over all CPR skills.

Should allow to perform needle decompression and chest drain

Should have IV arm with veins that IV accesses as a part of drug therapy.

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The manikin should generate all ACLS normal and abnormal ECG rhythms.

The manikin should be able to receive real Defib shock of 360/200 Joules.

The manikin should have automatic carotid, brachial and radial pulse, the pulse should have synchronized with ECG and blood pressure.

The manikin should have facility to have vocal sounds for patient to participant communication. The manikin should have visible chest rise coordinating with the set respiratory rate. The lung sound, chest rise and RR should coordinate with each other.

The manikin should be controlled by a wireless, touch screen control unit.

4. Pocket mask Adult

- The unit must be powered by cell batteries contained in a battery case simulating actual AED battery
- The AED Trainer must contain a status display window that can be manually changed by the instructor
- The AED Trainer must contain an LED display indicating selection of volume level and scenario chosen
- The AED Trainer must simulate the following conditions in preprogrammed scenarios and be able manually override them with the remote control
 - Artifact motion
 - Poor pad placement
 - Correct pad placement
 - Shockable rhythm
 - Non-shockable rhythm
 - Low Battery
 - Replace Battery
 - Error Condition

Bidders will have to arrange for a functional demonstration of the offered mannequins on the notified date.
