

International Trauma Life Support (ITLS) American College of Emergency Physicians (ACEP)

ITLS is accepted internationally as the standard training course for pre-hospital trauma care. ITLS courses combine classroom learning and hands-on skill stations. Scenario assessment stations enable student to put himself in simulated trauma situations. To be certified, a course must be taught by registered ITLS instructors under the sponsorship of ITLS International, an ITLS chapter, or an ITLS training centre. ITLS empowers health care personnel with the knowledge and skills to provide optimal care for the trauma victims, EMRI GHS has been accorded a chapter status organization by ITLS, USA.

ITLS-Basic

Certified as: **ITLS Basic Provider**

Prerequisites: The candidate must be an entry level EMS provider such as basic Emergency Medical Technician or other allied Health professional who holds suitable qualifications for entry

Criteria to be certified as ITLS Basic provider

A student has to attend all the lectures and skill stations, should get at least 74% in the written test and qualified as "adequate" in patient assessment.

ITLS-Advanced

Certified as: **ITLS Advanced Provider**

Prerequisites: The candidate must be an advanced level practitioner such as certified EMT-Advanced, Paramedic, Nurse, Physician, or other allied Health professional who holds suitable qualifications for entry.

Criteria to be certified as ITLS Advanced provider

A student has to attend all the lectures and skill stations, should get at least 74% in the written test and qualified as "adequate" in patient assessment.

ITLS Basic: EMT- Basic, Nurses, Physician assistants and other healthcare providers who deals with trauma patients

ITLS Advanced: EMT- Advanced, Paramedics, Sr.Nurses, Physicians and other advanced healthcare Physician assistants,providers

Batch Size: Minimum enrolment per batch: 15
